



Child Protection Information for Visitors to YCID BEIJING

Dear Visitor,

Welcome to Yew Chung International School of Beijing and we hope you enjoy your experience with our school community.

YCID Beijing is committed to providing a safe environment to all our students and therefore we have expectations of visitors regarding child protection. Please take the time to read through these expectations. If you have any questions or concerns please raise them with a staff member or security.

Visiting Adults will:

- Sign in at the gate and wear their Visitor's Pass at all times when on campus
- Treat all students with respect and provide safe and supportive interactions
- Ensure there is always a member of staff or school representative present during activities with students and that you do not work alone with students
- Report any unacceptable and / or concerning behavior from a student or adult

Visiting Adults will not:

- Take photos or videos of students unless you have received the school's permission
- Provide students with your personal contact information , or accept personal contact information from students
- Make any contact with YCID students outside of sanctioned YCID activities
- Act in a way that can be perceived as threatening or intrusive
- Initiate or respond to any physical contact from students.
- Engage in any form of harassment, bullying or inappropriate discipline
- Give any individual students gifts of any form, without informing their parents or the school leaders prior to the visit
- Accept any form of physical, verbal or emotional abuse from a student. If this does occur, immediately report it to a member of the YCID school staff
